

CAMPER DISCIPLINE PROCEDURE

There are times when Campers act out. This is how Fishkill Recreation will be handling these times.

The 3 Strike Rule:

Campers will be allowed 2 *STRIKES* per week. After 3 *STRIKES* in a week, the Camper will not be allowed to attend camp on Friday. **NO REFUND.**

CAMPERS CAN GET A STRIKE FOR:

- \Rightarrow Cursing
- ⇒ Running away
- \Rightarrow Not staying with the group
- ⇒ Not listening to his/her counselor/staff
- \Rightarrow Hitting, kicking, biting, fighting with other Campers
- \Rightarrow Name calling

Campers are told of this Policy each Monday, at the beginning of the Camp Week.

If a Counselor needs to send the Camper to the Director or Assistant Director for disciplining, the camper receives a *STRIKE*. Only the Director or Assistant Directors can assign *STRIKES*.

The Parent will be notified of their child's behavior and of each *STRIKE*.

If the Camper continues to cause problems, he/she will not be able to attend Camp for the rest of the summer. NO REFLINDS.

^{*}However, the strike policy is not limited to the actions above.
